The CHB Show Committee is very pleased to invite you to our Annual Fall Poultry Show. We feel privileged to host a show during these precarious times and we sincerely appreciate your support and cooperation to make it a great experience for everyone. We welcome all exhibitors, fanciers, spectators and family members, however building capacity limits will be monitored. Masks are mandatory inside the building – no exceptions.

This is a one-day show, with judging and awards presentation to be finished by late afternoon on Saturday. Birds will be released after awards are announced.

Covid-19 Protocols: Please stay informed of health restrictions currently in place for indoor events in Alberta prior to attending. CHB will comply with all compulsory measures imposed by the province and Alberta Health Services at the time of this show.

Cancellation: If circumstances require that we must cancel the show, exhibitors will be notified via email, and all fees that have been paid in advance will be refunded.
Please do not attend if you are experiencing symptoms of illness.

Food Services

A concession will be available in the show hall during the day on Saturday. Unfortunately, a Saturday evening exhibitor's dinner or social gathering will not be possible this year.

Bird Buying and Selling:

A sales area will be available for buying and selling birds during show hours. Bird selling spaces are reserved for EXHIBITORS ONLY, so you must have birds entered in the show to be eligible. Sales cage holes must be reserved and paid for with your show entries. There are limited cages available, and they will be assigned on a first come, first served basis.

Cost: \$5 per Large Fowl hole.

Sorry, no bantam, turkey or goose cages will be available.

Payment for cage spaces may be done along with your entry fees. CHB website will have a Paypal option or, use e-transfer if you prefer.

Your sales cage is one-time fee, so you may bring extra birds along and re-fill your spot as your birds are sold throughout the day. Birds brought to sell need to be healthy and in good condition, and preferably good, standard-bred examples of the breed.

Multiple birds may be displayed in each hole, however over-crowding is not allowed.

Exhibitors are also welcome to sell birds they have entered in the show for no additional fee.

Please do not advertise them for sale until after the class has been judged and it's been determined that the bird will not be moving forward in the competition. Birds are not to leave the showroom until after ALL judging is completed, and awards have been announced.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Due to sporting events taking place in Olds that weekend, hotel rooms are in short supply and are booking up very fast. You are encouraged to reserve a room as early as possible!

General Show Rules

1. **Entering.** All entries must be **RECEIVED by Nov. 5, 2021. No late entries will be accepted.** Show entries can be made through the online form on the CHB website or by sending the printable form via email, text message or fax as per instructions on form.
2. **Payment.** Entries are \$4.00 each. Trios are \$10.00. **An exhibitor fee of \$10.00** will be applied to all Open Show exhibitors. Please add \$10 on to your bird/egg entry total. This fee does not apply to Junior Exhibitors. Late entries will not be accepted. **All entry fees must be paid in full by Nov 5th, 2021.** No fees will be accepted at the show. Entry fees are non-refundable, except if the show is cancelled. Exhibitors who do not show up, or who pull their entries, will not be reimbursed. Payments can be made through the website via Paypal, by e-transfer to CHB email address, or by cheque payable to Canadian Heritage Breeds. See the website, payments page: [CHB payments.html](#)
3. **Photographs and/or video may be taken** at this event. The images resulting from the photography/video filming may be appear on social media, CHB's website or be used for other educational purposes to help achieve CHB's goals. If you do not wish yourself or your children to be photographed, be sure to inform a representative of CHB and avoid areas where and when filming is taking place.
4. **Entries.** All poultry entries must include Breed, Variety and Sex.
 - Junior and Open Show Egg Entries are to be entered as a group of three. The group of 3 eggs constitutes one entry. If known, please specify the breed that produced the eggs. (See Egg Show Class section).
 - Painted/decorated eggs are to be entered individually - one egg per entry.
 - Indicate Open or Junior division for all Egg Show categories.*Junior Exhibitors: Please include your age for painted or decorated egg entries.
5. **Showmanship.** There will be a Junior Showmanship competition. There is no fee or prior registration needed to take part. Please advise a CHB representative upon arrival at the show if you have a child that is interested in participating. Contestants will be instructed on the time and place to meet.
6. **Consent.** In making an entry, the exhibitor agrees to be governed by the rules and regulations stated.
7. **Bird Health/Vaccination** As a precaution, exhibitors are strongly urged to use a regular vaccination schedule to protect against I.L.T. (Infectious Laryngotracheitis is a reportable disease in Alberta). Birds should be vaccinated at least 30 days prior to the show.
 - a. **Outbreak.** CHB reserves the right to cancel the show in the event of a poultry disease outbreak such as Avian Influenza. In this situation, CHB will notify all registered exhibitors via email and any paid entry fees will be refunded.

b. Refusal. All entries must be clean and healthy. The committee reserves the right to reject birds suffering from illness or shown in an unfit condition, and can order removal of those entries at any time.

- 8. Ownership:** All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the date of the show.
- 9. Interference.** No one except the show committee officials are allowed to handle exhibits without the permission of the owner. Any exhibitor caught tampering with, altering, or injuring exhibits of any competitor will be disqualified from the competition.
- 10. Judge's authority.** The judge's decisions are to be respected. The judge shall have the authority to withhold awards at his/her discretion as merited by the exhibit.
- 11. Bands.** Leg bands are not required for poultry.
- 12. Substitutions.** You may make substitutions within the class, provided the Section and Class remains the same as the original entry.
- 13. Judging Guidelines:** The latest revised American Standard of Perfection and American Bantam Standard shall be the guide in all poultry entries judged. Specimens must be exhibited in their natural condition, except: Old English Games, Modern Games and American Games cocks, large and bantam, must be dubbed. Canada Geese, Mallard Ducks, Wood Duck and Mandarin Ducks can be pinioned.
Eggs: The entry of three eggs will be evaluated according to:
 - Shell colour and correctness for breed
 - Size, shape, uniformity, shell texture (including absence of cracks)Artificial polishing or shiny/glossy coatings will result in disqualification.

- 14. Coop-in:** All Poultry, Waterfowl, Turkeys, Guinea Fowl and Eggs (Open and Juniors) **must be caged by 9:00 am** on the morning of the show. Cooping-in may start when set-up is completed on Friday evening until 10:00 pm, and on Saturday morning from 7:30 – 9:00 am. Judging will begin by 10:00 am.
- 15. Coop-out.** Birds may be removed after ALL judging is completed and awards have been presented. In exceptional circumstances the committee may grant an exhibitor permission to take birds out early. All exhibits are to be removed from the show area by 9:00 am Sunday. Tear-down help is greatly appreciated!
