A note concerning this year's Show:

We are pleased to welcome you to our Annual Fall Show. Our number one priority is for everyone to have a safe and enjoyable show experience. This means we must all do our part and follow the extra rules that are in place due to the ongoing Covid-19 situation. This is a one-day show, however exhibitors are welcome to bring their birds in on Friday evening and remove them Sunday morning if they wish. There will be no banquet or social gathering planned. All Exhibitors are required to read the information contained in this booklet, and agree to abide by the terms.

General Show Rules

1. All entries must be **RECEIVED by November 6th, 2020**. All exhibitors are required to register themselves, plus any family members who will be attending with them. This is the only way for us to track attendance accurately. No additional people will be admitted once the maximum number has been reached. Use the online entry system on the CHB website, or contact Rico directly via email or cell (contact information is on the entry form). It is important to get your entries in early to be guaranteed admittance. Due to the current gathering restrictions, unregistered exhibitors or spectators will not be permitted.
2. All entries are \$4.00 each. Late or unpaid entries will not be accepted. **All fees must be paid in full at the time entries are submitted.** Payments will be accepted online via Paypal or e-transfer. Entry form with cheque may be mailed.
3. CHB reserves the right to cancel the show, based on insufficient entries. In the event that insufficient poultry or pigeon entries are received, all exhibitors will be notified promptly and any fees they have paid will be refunded in full.
4. **The Pigeon Show will be a basket show format.** Exhibitors will be assigned a table area for their carriers, rather than a show coop for each bird. Birds will be brought forward for judging as classes are called. Please contact the show secretary if you have questions or wish to request show coops for an additional fee of \$10 for 4 holes.
5. Photographs and/or video may be taken at this event. The images resulting from the photography/video filming may be appear on social media, CHB's website or be used for other educational purposes to help achieve CHB's goals. If you do not wish to be photographed be sure to inform a representative of CHB.

6. All poultry entries must include Breed, Variety and Sex.
 - Egg/eggs entries can be entered as a group of three at \$4.00/entry. Please specify colour and breed that produced the eggs if known. (See Egg Show Class section).
 - Painted or decorated eggs are to be entered individually, one egg at a time.
 - There is a Junior Division for the decorated/painted egg show.
7. There will be a Showmanship competition included in this show. There is no fee or separate registration required for Showmanship.
8. In making an entry, the exhibitor agrees to be governed by the rules and regulations.
9. As a precaution, exhibitors are **strongly** urged to use a regular vaccination schedule to protect against I.L.T. All birds should be vaccinated at least 30 days prior to the show.
10. CHB reserves the right to cancel the show in the event of a poultry disease outbreak such as Avian Influenza. In this situation, CHB will notify all registered exhibitors via email and entry fees will be returned.
11. All entries must be clean and healthy. The committee reserves the right to reject entries suffering from disease or shown in an unfit condition, and can order the removal of those entries at any time.
12. All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor at least 30 days prior to the date of the show.
13. No one except the officials of the show will be allowed to handle the exhibit without the permission of the owner. Any exhibitor caught tampering with or in any way injuring exhibits of any competitor will be disqualified.
14. The judge shall have power to withhold awards at his/her discretion and will be instructed to the effect that no award is to be given unless the exhibit is worthy. The judge's decision is final.
15. Leg band information is not required for the Poultry.
16. You may make substitutions within the class provided the class and section remains the same as the original entry.
17. All specimens must be exhibited in their natural condition except for: All Old English Games, Modern Games and American Games Cocks and Cockerels large and bantam must be dubbed. Canada Geese, Mallard Ducks, Wood Duck and Mandarin Ducks can be pinioned.
18. The latest revised American Standard of Perfection and American Bantam Standard shall be the guide in all poultry entries judged.
19. All Poultry, Waterfowl, Turkeys, Guinea Fowl and Eggs (Open and Juniors) must be caged by 9:00 AM on the morning of the show.
20. Birds may not be removed until after ALL judging is completed. All exhibits are to be removed by 9:00 am Sunday.
21. There will be no separate sales area. Private selling is permitted. No birds may be removed until judging is complete.

Additional Event Guidelines

This event will follow advisories and restrictions issued by the Government of Alberta. If circumstances in the province change and we are required to cancel the event, all registered exhibitors will be promptly notified via email and their entry fees will be refunded.

Please read the following carefully, and be aware that rules and restrictions may continue to change as the date of the event draws closer.

- Anyone who has experienced symptoms of illness within two weeks prior to the event will not be admitted.
- The number of participants will be strictly monitored, with only registered exhibitors and their immediate family members are allowed. There will be no admittance of general public for viewing. Anyone entering birds in the show is required to state the number of people from their immediate household who will be attending with them.
- The total number of attendees (including family members) will be capped to comply with indoor gathering regulations. Exhibitors will be accepted and counted in the order in which their entries are received and paid in full.
- The onus is on the exhibitors to take responsibility for their own safety and that of their family. Attendees are responsible for wearing masks and following physical distancing and hand washing protocols. Exhibitors are encouraged to supply their own hand sanitizer, masks etc.
- All fees must be paid in full at the time entries are submitted via Paypal or e-transfer. No payments of membership dues or other administrative services will be available the day of the show. Refunds will ONLY be issued if the event is cancelled. People who withdraw their entries or decide not to show up will not be reimbursed.
